

IN-ROOM SAFE

Please utilize the safe in your room to store your valuables.

DOUBLE LOCK & BOLT YOUR DOOR

Utilize the deadbolt provided on your door. This will prevent the door from being unlocked with a regular room key.

ROOM KEYS

Do not leave your key in the room or give it to others. Please notify the front desk immediately should you lose your room key.

HOW TO SURVIVE A FIRE

In case of a fire, the National Safety Council recommends these procedures:

Familiarize yourself with the locations of the fire exits and count the number of doors from your room to the nearest fire exit. If the corridor is filled with smoke, you may not be able to see the exit, but you can feel your way along the floor.

Get into the habit of keeping your key in the same place every time you stay at a hotel so you'll always know exactly where it is. If you have to leave your room, be sure to take your key with you. If you cannot reach the exit, you may have to return to your room and wait for assistance.

If you wake up and find your room beginning to fill with smoke, grab your key and head for the door on your hands and knees. This will save your eyes and lungs for as long as possible. Also, the air five or six feet up may be filled with odorless carbon monoxide.

Before leaving the room, feel the door with the palm of your hand. If the door is hot or even warm, do not open it! If it is room temperature, slowly open it a crack and peek into the hallway to see what is happening. If the hallway is clear, crawl out feeling your way along the exit side of the wall. It's easy to get lost or disoriented in smoke. Count the doors as you go. Do not use an elevator as a fire exit. Smoke, heat and fire may put it out of operation. When you reach the exit, walk down the stairs to the fire exit door. If you encounter smoke in the stairwell on the way down, do not try to run through it! Instead, go to the highest floor and wait for assistance.

If you cannot get out of your room safely, fill the bathtub or sink with water. Soak towels with water and stuff them under the doors and between the cracks to keep the smoke out. With your ice bucket, bail water onto the door and walls to keep them cool. Saturate your mattress and put it against the door. Put a wet towel over your face to help you breathe.

DO NOT JUMP unless you are certain of injury if you stay in your room one minute longer. Most people hurt themselves jumping, even from the second floor. If you are higher than the third floor, chances are you won't survive the fall. You would be better off fighting the fire in your room.



Normandy Farm



1730

The history of the property dates back over 290 years to 1730, when it was first purchased by Jacob Levering. Not much is known about the Mr. Levering, except that he eventually passed the land, originally 68 acres, onto his daughter Catherine and her husband, Jacob Heist.

1834

In 1834, Catherine and Jacob built "The Franklin House" or "Franklinville Inn" on the property, which is believed to be the core of the main house that sits on Morris Road. This tavern became a popular restaurant and lodging house for those traveling along what at the time was the newly constructed state road between Norristown and Doylestown in Bucks County.

1873

The property did not gain recognition until 1873, when Mr. William Singerly, a prominent Philadelphia businessman, purchased all 68 acres and used it as his country home. He named the property "The Record Farm" after the Philadelphia Record newspaper, which he purchased in 1877.

1875

Even though Mr. Singerly was at heart a businessman, he had a very active interest in Farming, and in 1875 built the massive barn that you still see standing over 140 years later. The barn is over 200 feet long and nearly 50 feet wide, and at the time was the largest barn in the United States. Mr. Singerly continued to acquire land, eventually growing his farm to 825 acres. He built several other barns and structures on his property to house his cattle, sheep, horses and employees that worked the farm. The farm was extremely successful and became famous for pioneering new farming and agricultural techniques.

1913

When he died in 1898, it was discovered that Mr. Singerly had amassed massive debt, and the land was eventually broken up and sold off to various local farmers. In 1901, a Mr. William Wilson purchased the land that contained the farmhouse and barn, and he eventually sold it to Ralph Strassburger. Like Mr. Singerly, Mr. Strassburger was a prominent Philadelphia businessman who harbored an interest in farming and agriculture. Mr. Strassburger renamed the property "Normandy Farm", after Normandy, France, where he honeymooned with his wife, the daughter of the president of the Singer Sewing Machine Company.

1928

Sometime in the late 1920's the white stucco walls that you see surrounding the property were built. Mr. Strassburger also added the design touches you see today. He also continued the tradition of running a state-of-the-art farming facility. Unfortunately, instead of amassing debt like the farm's previous owner, Mr. Singerly, Mr. Strassburger was indicted for failing to pay some \$12,000 in income taxes. He and his family escaped off to live in France where he eventually died in 1959. After his death, his wife and son came back to live on the property.

2000

Over the years, the Strassburger family gradually sold off pieces of property until his son Peter died in 1993. The land was left with two distant cousins, who had no real connection to the farm. They eventually sold the property to various other land developers, with Hansen Properties, Inc. acquiring the land surrounding the barn and the other historic structures.

2025

Today, Normandy Farm Hotel and Blue Bell Country Club together comprise one of largest hospitality centers in region. Located immediately adjacent to each other and with common ownership, these facilities are on over 210 acres, with more than 220,000 square feet of indoor space, and significant outdoor amenities including an 18-hole Arnold Palmer Signature Golf Course and a Philadelphia Business Journal Top 10 Largest Meeting Site. Guests can enjoy a wide selection of experiences, including fine dining, elegant ballrooms, state-of-the-art conference and meeting facilities, a historic hotel, championship golf, swimming, and fitness. With over \$6.7 million in hotel restoration and golf course renovations in the past 5 years, we invite you to check-in for 2 landmark destinations and *One Historic Experience*.

You don't need to be a risk-taker to pop in on a whim. Your spontaneity will be rewarded with modern farm cooking from local, heirloom and seasonal ingredients. Chef Mtele Abubakar hails from Kenya and has lived and cooked all over the world. He brings the sensibilities of farm life and rustic cooking to the farmer's daughter's kitchen.

"What we're doing here isn't a fad—it's a way of life," says Chef Abu. "On our farm, there was no refrigeration. Everything was made fresh that day. I learned to braise in a hole in the ground, using authentic ingredients to enhance dishes so the natural flavors shine. Here, we're making traditional dishes with a twist."

This unexpected take on cooking is a curious mix of fine dining and ranch house. Nothing goes to waste as the kitchen fabricates (read: breaks down) meats and fish in-house and employs the nose to tail philosophy: use it all. Mtele and his staff make virtually everything you'll enjoy right down to pestos, dressings and sauces. The options are endless for lunch, dinner, and Sunday Brunch. It's easy to see why the farmer's daughter works for a business lunch, a family dinner, date night or a guys' or a ladies' night out.

In the spirit of risk taking—or, perhaps, just a whim—dive into the cocktail program. Fans of bourbons, wines and beer won't be disappointed as those selections are robust and, like everything else here, change on a whim. The 12 taps are predominantly craft beer, many from Pennsylvania's stellar breweries. If that's not enough, there's a full bar with talented bartenders to create your favorites. But, then again, you never know what you'll find at the bar; you just know it will be outstanding.


